Holy Mass and Candlelit Eucharistic STREET PROCESSION to Honour Christ The King



Special Relic of St Catherine Labouré

Comes to Melbourne, Holy Cross Church, Sunday 9th December

St Catherine Labouré is one of the best known and loved Saints in the entire Church. She was the one chosen by God to receive the vision of Our Lady and that most precious gift destined for the whole world, the Miraculous Medal.

Both Our Lord and Our Lady appeared to Her as well as the famous St Vincent de Paul, the founder of her Congregation. Our Lady made many prophesies through St Catherine Labouré which all came true so that everyone could believe and accept the authenticity of the visions. The details were clear: the end of the French monarchy, a time of revolt, the murder of the Archbishop and the martyrdom of the clergy, all of which came to pass exactly as she prophesied.

Pure and holy, and faithful to the end, she is one of those

elect saints who are incorrupt. One can still see her incorrupt body in the Chapel of the Visitation at Rue de Bac, Paris, even today. Since St Catherine Labouré is incorrupt we feel we are especially blessed to have her holy First Class relic coming to Melbourne for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception in December.

Free Miraculous Medals will be given to all who attend.



Our Lady of Guadalupe

Patroness of the Americas (Latin America and USA)

Close to a billion souls come under the direct patronage of Our Lady of Guadalupe. It is believed that the shrine in Mexico City, where She appeared receives more pilgrims each year than any other shrine in the whole world: around 20 million pilgrims each year. On Her Feast day alone at estimated 6 million plus give reverence to Our Lady at this unique site.

We had the privilege to visit the Shrine in 2000. It was an unforgettable experience. Apart from the miraculous image, one of the memories most deeply engraved on the mind was the scene before the sunrise. Looking out over the huge square (much bigger than St Peter's Square in Rome) was as a sea of pilgrims sleeping under the stars. It looked like hundreds of thousands sleeping in the cold Mexican night on the cold hard pavement with just a thin blanket or coat for their protection. They were not perturbed at all as they were pleased to be under the mantle and care of Mary, their loving mother.

Now regarding the apparitions: The simple peasant farmer, a convert to Catholicism, who saw Our Lady in 1509, is now a canonised Saint, the first native born Saint of Latin America, Saint Juan Diego. There are three wonderful points we would like to share with you about these marvellous apparitions.

Firstly, Our Lady spoke with such tenderness to St Juan. **“Do not fear..... Am I not here, I, who am your Mother? Are you not under my shadow and protection? Am I not the source of your joy? Are you not in the hollow of my mantle, in the crossing of my arms?”**

Secondly, Our Lady left us, what is unquestionably one of the most incredible images we have of Her. At the request of the Bishop Our Lady produced the most remarkable sign. She made roses bloom in the winter! These were collected by Saint Juan in his cloak. When in front of his bishop the cloak was dropped open a miraculous image appeared at that moment. The image has been thoroughly tested scientifically, and led to the conversion of those scientists who investigated because they can see that it is an image made by heaven.

Thirdly, Our Lady performed one of the most amazing miracles of all times through this visitation and through this miraculous image: The conversion of an entire nation to faith in Her Son Jesus Christ.



Mary's Immaculate Conception

The title of Mary as the "Immaculate Conception", is a title that is clearly loved by God. This is why when Mary was sent by God and appeared to St Catherine Labouré in 1830 in order to give the world that very special sacramental the miraculous medal, it came with the inscription, "Oh Mary Conceived Without Sin...." This is also why He directed the Mother of God to reveal at Lourdes, "I am the Immaculate Conception."

And in between these two great apparitions of the 19th Century the Holy Spirit directed the Church to solemnly pronounce that Our Lady was conceived and preserved from all stain of original sin and personal sin throughout Her whole life.

So why was this gift stored up for this later modern era, the time characterised by the Industrial Revolution?

God no doubt foresaw that this would be an age of increasing godlessness and strife, an era in which sin would be trivialised, and where great immorality would flourish. The title



reminds us that sin is not acceptable to God. It reminds us that God wants us to come ever closer to Him and to be cleansed from sinful ways of thinking and acting. Finally, it was proclaimed to give us a beacon of light and hope.

Just as Jesus gave Mother Mary to us at the foot of the Cross and placed us under Her loving care, God has seen fit to give us Mary once again under the most beautiful title of the Immaculate Conception as a sign of hope and protection. Who can lead us out of the darkness into the light of Her Son if it is not the one who is free from all sin, and who is filled with every spiritual perfection.

Otherwise you may like to do it for the best motivation of all: for love of Our Lady, for the conversion of the world and for the Triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
